# NOTEWORTHY EVENTS

- Area Commanders conducted quarterly meetings in several sectors
- Officers visited South Tamarind and Heritage Elementary Schools as part of “Literacy Week”
- Officers seized over 100 pounds of methamphetamine on a traffic stop
- Patrol assisted the FUSD in response to a hoax active shooter call at Fontana High School
- COPE attended an event at Poplar Elementary School for “Career Day”
- Animal Services hosted a pet vaccine clinic
- COPE hosted a BBQ event at Solorio Elementary School
- Cold Case Detective Katie Clark arrested an individual for a homicide that occurred over 34 years ago in Fontana
- Patrol Officers seized over 500,000 fentanyl pills during an investigation
- RRT and Gang Units seized numerous illegal firearms in several investigations

  - Crimes Against Society- 210




